

MYFUTURE: USER INFORMATION

[myfuture](#) is a national online information and exploration service that assists career planning, career pathways and work transitions. It provides information and support for career development for individuals and for those who support or influence career choices.

Schools have free access to all sections of the myfuture service.

To access myfuture, staff and students should follow the steps outlined below.

1. Log in to <http://myfuture.edu.au> using current details or sign up for a new account.
2. Go to the **Account details** section.
3. Ensure the email address is the Department ...*education.wa.edu.au* email address.
4. Go to your email and select the activation link and open it in the same browser.

myfuture was relaunched by Education Services Australia in October 2015 with changes and new features including:

- a simplified version of *My Career Profile*;
- interactive, digital Bullseyes allowing users to explore occupations by preferred learning areas, with direct interactive links to the full occupation profile pages;
- new and updated articles by industry experts in the *Career insight* section;
- simplified industry information providing a snapshot of trending job prospects for a particular industry, with links to related occupations and associated industries;
- occupational profile pages with links to related courses, earnings data, job prospect predictions and links to similar occupations; and
- new business profile features enabling key businesses and associations to showcase traditional, non-traditional and emerging career pathways.

Further updates are planned throughout 2016 including case studies mapped to occupation profiles; more business, industry and higher education institute profiles; training provider information; cadetships and internships; and volunteering information.

In late 2016, you will also be able to access and save information in a personalised, digital portfolio. Personalised content will be delivered at relevant times, based on each user's life stage, interests, aptitude test outcomes and location.
