President's Report

- Awaiting video copy of the "Last Post" performance from the ANZAC assembly
- Some well known musicians have been invited to perform at KSHS towards the end of the year. This is only in the planning stages as yet.
- Theo's Music is closing down. Good opportunity to buy instruments at a very good price. AS to email all parents.

Treasurer's Report

- current balance as at 11/5/18 \$1,878.19

Business arising from last minutes:

- MID YEAR CONCERT
 - FK to see if she can organise a videographer if other parent volunteer is unable to help.
 - MR has prepared draft of running order and should have order finalised by tomorrow

- Some discussion of using the KPAC's live streaming features to show the music students waiting back stage what's happening on stage. Was felt to be too complicated unless we have a volunteer who knows what they're doing with the existing equipment.
- Video of the event will be used as a teaching tool
- Announcement that before performance starts that there will be no intermission (thus, toilet breaks to be taken between acts)
- Tickets selling out very quickly. TryBooking has the option to return unused tickets – email HA to arrange. AS to email everyone to let them know to return extra tickets through HA. AS to talk to KSHS office about what to do with returned tickets.
- HA to arrange \$50 float and raffle tickets
- AS to arrange hat and signage
- MUSIC CAMP
 - Discussion about how to transport all the instruments and equipment. AS to investigate costs of hiring a removal truck. This would keep everything dry and would mean everything could be transported in one load. Last year there were three full trailers, and four full cars worth. FK suggests asking Kalamunda Bus Service for a donation of a bus. The booking is currently with Paul's Bus Service and they give KSHS a good rate.
 - MR to send digital copy of camp note to AS for emailing to all parents – some parents haven't received them yet.
- Music Folios and Transportable Storage for Junior Band – MV still investigating options. Some discussion about putting in a submission to the KSHS finance committee by this Friday 15th June. Considered unlikely.
