#### President's Report

Welcome to all parents, particularly the two new parents present this evening. This is MR's fifth year at KSHS and the music program has gone from strength to strength. Parent support has helped to reinvigorate the program which has in turn increased the number of students and the scope of the musical opportunities at KSHS.

Last year's aims were to consolidate the new initiatives from previous years, and this has been achieved. There is a new strings program offered in feeder primary schools which is beginning to have flow on effects in the string groups at KSHS. The KPA Music stream has continued to grow in popularity and offers highly sought-after places to talented students wishing to attend KSHS.

During the school year, the Music Department was able to continue to hold performance events such as the Mid-Year Concert and the Twilight Concert as well as community events like the Ziggy Zagdust performance (held in conjunction with the Zig Zag Festival co-ordinators), the Kalamunda Show and several other smaller events.

Three of the Cert III students from last year (Year 12s) have gone on to study music at Universities – two have been accepted as WAAPA and one to Monash Uni.

It is a good time to get involved in MusiKal – there is an established culture of high performance in the students backed up with an experienced teaching team and solid support base amongst the parents.

### SECRETARY'S NOTE:

During the year, the MusiKal group has contributed \$1500 towards Music Camp costs, subsidised music uniform shirts \$825, purchased "crew vests" \$198, bought a new backdrop curtain for the Twilight Concert Stage \$302 and bought new instruments for the school \$1726

Ongoing committed funds: Music shirt subsidy \$945 for the 2018 calendar year (\$459 already spent)

### General business

- School budget has been cut in general, and Music Dept budget has been cut by approximately \$5,000. MusiKal may have to revise its funding goals to support this decrease.
- Music camp costs looking to be approximately \$150 per child
- Performances coming up: KPA Junior Showcase, ANZAC assembly 10<sup>th</sup> April, Kalamunda Show 13<sup>th</sup> April
- Mid-Year concert 19<sup>th</sup> June – HA to arrange ticketing and handover to another member for future years
- Lighting options for Main Quad stage lighting to be investigated
- MusiKal thanks Tracey Holland for her assistance in getting the students ready on photo day. Her organisation skills were very much appreciated
