President's Report

- Mid Year concert, Music Camp and Kalamunda Day coming up soon. Discussed in General Business

Treasurer's Report

- No report tabled. Balance hasn't changed significantly since AGM when balance was \$1028.98

Business arising from last minutes:

- MusiKal discussed facilitating student performances by matching performers with venues and providing practical assistance. AS has not yet emailed students but will do so this month
- Noted that Kalamunda Shire is hosting several events which may be of interest to performance students: Busking Day at the Farmer's market, and Music performance events through Youth Focus. Students taking part in these activities will be encouraged to send photos in to MR.

New business

1. MID YEAR CONCERT 25 JUNE

- Draft order of performances being formulated but looking like guitar groups and Junior Band on first, Senior band on last performing "Policies, Processes and Pain" by Peter Hind. No intermission again this year.
- Considering not having a side stage this year and instead having soloists/small groups perform in front of the curtain while bigger groups getting set up behind. MusiKal thanks ML for offering to run side stage if it is decided to go with this idea.
- General discussion of types of groups available and who might play where

- Ticketing to be set up by EA and MV. New ticket price of \$10 each and request audience to limit purchase to 4 per family. Wheelchair accessible seats to be reserved. VIP seats reserved
- AS to email note and call for donations to all MusiKal subscribers.
- SB, GW, ML and AM possible volunteer helpers (thanks!)
- All available seats needed from reception area

2. OPUS CONCERT 1 JULY 2019

- IMMS Government Schools music program showcase. Very hotly contested to get a position in the event
- Peter Hind's composition "Policies, Processes and Pain" about the Stolen Generations to have its premier performance.
- First time in memory of current music staff that KSHS has been selected
- Tickets free but must be booked through school. AS to email all for last minute tickets (tickets close 12 Jun)
- Bus booked to bring students to Perth Concert Hall for 12.30pm, some work to do to get permission slips and excursion paperwork ready prior to event.
- AS proposes that MusiKal lend three Lesmurdie/other school students performance uniform shirts. These three students will be playing with the KSHS Senior Band at the Opus Concert at the Perth Concert Hall on 1 July 2019. Unanimously agreed.

3. MUSIC CAMP 6TH AND 7TH AUGUST

- Notes distributed and email notes sent to all subscribers
- AS to collate health and dietary information as last year
- 2 buses booked for expected 110 students
- Contemporary guitar teacher not able to attend camp, so will host an in-house "camp" for contemp. guitar students on Wednesday 7th.
