President's Report

- All on track for Wednesday's recording of the new School Song. Concert Bands and strings to do soundscape, then guitars, brass, strings and choir to record song. AS proposes budget of \$150 to provide morning tea for staff and students. FK seconds, unanimously agreed.
- AS to check with Helen Deacon about special rules which may apply during service of morning tea.

Treasurer's Report

- Balance of account \$3,171.19
- Petty cash from sales of performance uniform shirts now stands at \$11.80.
- MR has started putting schedule together: format to be similar to Twilight Concert format with two stages and smaller groups providing constant music.
 - Event to start around 11 with music in the art quad to accompany exhibition
 - 12 noon official opening and cake cutting ceremony
 - 12 – 1pm: contemporary guitar groups performing in the art quad
 - 1-3:30pm: Main quad stage setup with all groups and bands playing
 - 3:30 – 4pm: all Music Students to perform new School Song.
 - MusiKal to find out whether we can have a donation tub, can we run a raffle, is there a possibility of busking money to be donated to the school?
- Replacement PA
MR has received quotes, the best of which is from Manny's. \$3,800 for 2 monitor speakers, 2 reinforcement speakers, cables and subwoofer. After some discussion about committed funds MR proposes that MusiKal contribute half (being \$1900) with the other half to be supplied by School Finance Committee if acceptable. AS seconds, unanimously agreed.



New business

- Proposal to alternate meeting dates so that other members can attend – Monday doesn't suit everyone. General agreement. Next meeting date set for 13th October (this is the first day back at school in Term 4).
- Helen Deacon seeking information about where the time capsules from years past were buried. AS to send out email asking alumni to get in touch if they know where.
