The P&C started Term 3 by participating in the school NAIDOC day on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July. We were able to provide students tastings of native flavours as part of our EAT program. Amy and Tia put together some potato bites seasoned with edible native plants which included Old Man Saltbush (*Atriplex nummularia*), Native Mint (*Mentha Australis*) and Native Oregano (*Prostanthera rotundifolia*). This was complimented by kangaroo sausages cooked on the BBQ. There was also a Warrigal Greens and Macadamia nut salad in the mix. The food was well received by the students, and it was wonderful to see them enthusiastically trying new foods.

On Friday 1<sup>st</sup> August the P&C held another EAT activity. This involved providing a Japanese meal box that was available for order. The food was amazing, but we did have a hiccup with the timing of the serving of the meals to our students. This was due to a power outage which occurred at a critical time in the preparation of the meals. Apologies to all the students who experienced the delay in receiving their lunches and to the canteen staff who were impacted because of this. We will be reviewing the event to improve the experience for all involved.
